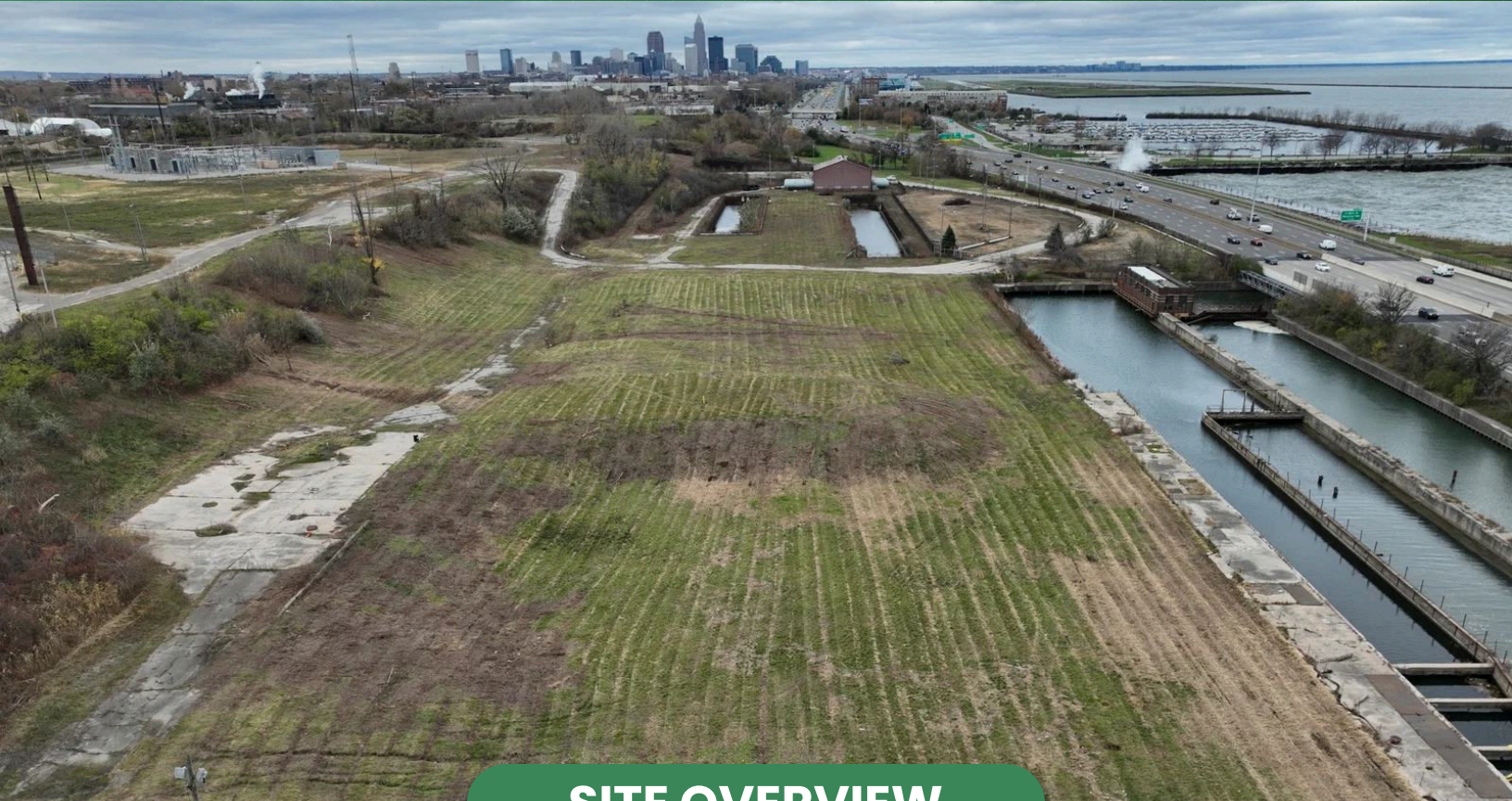

Description:

IDA's Lake Shore site sits on 60 acres set on the south side of I-90 overlooking Lake Erie. It is comprised of two developable parcels on separate elevations. The lower eastern pad is 11.65 acres, and the upper western pad is 13.72 acres.

The site was formerly operated as a coal fired power plant. The plant was demolished in 2017.

This site was selected for the 2025 ULI Hines Design Competition.
